## PARTICIPATING STUDENTS AT THE EVENT:

Free Physiotherapy Camp was held from 13<sup>th</sup> to 15th September 2024 at Kesariwada, Narayanpeth-Pune. Free Physiotherapy Camp was conducted for all the devotees (participants) for 3 days. There were 5 Stations present at the venue which evaluated their Basic demographic data, Body Mass Index, and Basic parameters like Blood Pressure, SPo2, Respiratory rate, and Pulse Rate. The other 2 stations were for evaluation and the last station was for Physiotherapy consultation and Treatment. The main aim of this physiotherapy camp was to evaluate problems faced by the devotees, consult, and treat them accordingly. We encountered around 90 participants on the 13<sup>th</sup>

of September 2024, 135 participants on the 14<sup>th</sup> of September 2024, and 255 participants on the 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2024. A total of 480 participants were evaluated and treated in all. Out of all the devotees, around 20% devotes were concerned about role of physiotherapy in Chikungunya and Dengue post infection.

Overall, the Physiotherapy camp was successful. It was well received and appreciated by all the participants (devotees).
